

**VILLAGE OF VOORHEESVILLE**  
**STORMWATER COMPLAINT AND CONCERNS PROCEDURES**

Stormwater management in the Village of Voorheesville is regulated by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation General Permit for stormwater discharge from a municipality.

The operation and maintenance of the storm sewer system is performed by the Village Department of Public Works in accordance with permit requirements. Stormwater management and runoff resulting from site construction is inspected and monitored by the Village or its consultant. Erosion and sedimentation controls are required to prevent pollution of the storm sewer system and nearby waterways.

Unauthorized discharges of chemicals and pollutants into the Village storm sewer system is a violation of the permit and subject to fines.

Should there be a situation where you feel there is a pollution concern, the Village can be contacted for you to document any issues for a response and to address the situation.

Residents can direct complaints, concerns or questions about general stormwater activities or construction related stormwater activities to the Village stormwater officer by phone or email. The inquiry will then be documented and investigated. A response will then be sent on how the matter was addressed.
